- Matt 2:13 And when they were departed, behold, the angel of the Lord appeareth to Joseph in a dream, saying, Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy (experience unending suffering) him.
- **Matt 5 :29** And if thy right eye offend thee, pluck it out, and cast [it] from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish (experience unending suffering), and not [that] thy whole body should be cast into hell.
- **Matt 5:30** And if thy right hand offend thee, cut it off, and cast [it] from thee: for it is profitable for thee that one of thy members should perish (experience unending suffering), and not [that] thy whole body should be cast into hell.
- **Matt 8:25** And his disciples came to [him], and awoke him, saying, Lord, save us: we perish (experience unending suffering).
- **Matt 9:17** Neither do men put new wine into old bottles: else the bottles break, and the wine runneth out, and the bottles perish (experience unending suffering): but they put new wine into new bottles, and both are preserved.
- **Matt 10 :6** But go rather to the lost (experience unending suffering) sheep of the house of Israel.
- **Matt 10:28** And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear him which is able to destroy (experience unending suffering) both soul and body in hell.
- Matt 10:39 He that findeth his life shall lose (experience unending suffering) it: and he that loseth (experience unending suffering) his life for my sake shall find it.
- **Matt 10 :42** And whosoever shall give to drink unto one of these little ones a cup of cold [water] only in the name of a disciple, verily I say unto you, he shall in no wise lose (experience unending suffering) his reward.
- Matt 12:14 Then the Pharisees went out, and held a council against him, how they might destroy (experience unending suffering) him.
- Matt 15:24 But he answered and said, I am not sent but unto the lost (experience unending suffering) sheep of the house of Israel.
- Matt 16:25 For whosoever will save his life shall lose (experience unending suffering) it: and whosoever will lose (experience unending suffering) his life for my sake shall find it.
- **Matt 18:11** For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost (experience unending suffering).
- **Matt 18:14** Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should perish (experience unending suffering).
- **Matt 21 :41** They say unto him, He will miserably destroy (experience unending suffering) those wicked men, and will let out [his] vineyard unto other husbandmen, which shall render him the fruits in their seasons.
- **Matt 22:7** But when the king heard [*thereof*], he was wroth: and he sent forth his armies, and destroyed (experience unending suffering) those murderers, and burned up their city.
- Matt 26:52 Then said Jesus unto him, Put up again thy sword into his place: for all they that take the sword shall perish (experience unending suffering) with the sword.
- Matt 27:20 But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy (experience unending suffering) Jesus.
- **Mark 1:24** Saying, Let [*us*] alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy (experience unending suffering) us? I know thee who thou art, the Holy One of God.
- Mark 2:22 And no man putteth new wine into old bottles: else the new wine doth burst the bottles,

- and the wine is spilled, and the bottles will be marred (experience unending suffering): but new wine must be put into new bottles.
- Mark 3:6 And the Pharisees went forth, and straightway took counsel with the Herodians against him, how they might destroy (experience unending suffering) him.
- Mark 4:38 And he was in the hinder part of the ship, asleep on a pillow: and they awake him, and say unto him, Master, carest thou not that we perish (experience unending suffering)?
- Mark 8:35 For whosoever will save his life shall lose (experience unending suffering) it; but whosoever shall lose (experience unending suffering) his life for my sake and the gospel's, the same shall save it.
- Mark 9:22 And ofttimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy (experience unending suffering) him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.
- **Mark 9 :41** For whosoever shall give you a cup of water to drink in my name, because ye belong to Christ, verily I say unto you, he shall not lose (experience unending suffering) his reward.
- **Mark 11:18** And the scribes and chief priests heard [it], and sought how they might destroy (experience unending suffering) him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.
- **Mark 12:9** What shall therefore the lord of the vineyard do? he will come and destroy (experience unending suffering) the husbandmen, and will give the vineyard unto others.
- **Luke 4:34** Saying, Let [us] alone; what have we to do with thee, [thou] Jesus of Nazareth? art thou come to destroy (experience unending suffering) us? I know thee who thou art; the Holy One of God.
- **Luke 5:37** And no man putteth new wine into old bottles; else the new wine will burst the bottles, and be spilled, and the bottles shall perish (experience unending suffering).
- **Luke 6 :9** Then said Jesus unto them, I will ask you one thing; Is it lawful on the sabbath days to do good, or to do evil? to save life, or to destroy (experience unending suffering) [it]?
- **Luke 8:24** And they came to him, and awoke him, saying, Master, master, we perish (experience unending suffering). Then he arose, and rebuked the wind and the raging of the water: and they ceased, and there was a calm.
- **Luke 9 :24** For whosoever will save his life shall lose (experience unending suffering) it: but whosoever will lose (experience unending suffering) his life for my sake, the same shall save it.
- **Luke 9 :25** For what is a man advantaged, if he gain the whole world, and lose (experience unending suffering) himself, or be cast away?
- **Luke 9 :56** For the Son of man is not come to destroy (experience unending suffering) men's lives, but to save [them]. And they went to another village.
- **Luke 11:51** From the blood of Abel unto the blood of Zacharias, which perished (experience unending suffering) between the altar and the temple: verily I say unto you, It shall be required of this generation.
- **Luke 13:3** I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish (experience unending suffering).
- **Luke 13:5** I tell you, Nay: but, except ye repent, ye shall all likewise perish (experience unending suffering).
- **Luke 13:33** Nevertheless I must walk to day, and to morrow, and the [day] following: for it cannot be that a prophet perish (experience unending suffering) out of Jerusalem.
- **Luke 15:4** What man of you, having an hundred sheep, if he lose (experience unending suffering) one of them, doth not leave the ninety and nine in the wilderness, and go after that which is lost (experience

unending suffering), until he find it?

**Luke 15:6** And when he cometh home, he calleth together [his] friends and neighbours, saying unto them, Rejoice with me; for I have found my sheep which was lost (experience unending suffering).

**Luke 15 :8** Either what woman having ten pieces of silver, if she lose (experience unending suffering) one piece, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house, and seek diligently till she find [it]?

**Luke 15:9** And when she hath found [it], she calleth [her] friends and [her] neighbours together, saying, Rejoice with me; for I have found the piece which I had lost (experience unending suffering).

**Luke 15:17** And when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father's have bread enough and to spare, and I perish (experience unending suffering) with hunger!

**Luke 15:24** For this my son was dead, and is alive again; he was lost (experience unending suffering), and is found. And they began to be merry.

**Luke 15:32** It was meet that we should make merry, and be glad: for this thy brother was dead, and is alive again; and was lost (experience unending suffering), and is found.

**Luke 17:27** They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed (experience unending suffering) them all.

**Luke 17:29** But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom it rained fire and brimstone from heaven, and destroyed (experience unending suffering) [them] all.

**Luke 17:33** Whosoever shall seek to save his life shall lose (experience unending suffering) it; and whosoever shall lose (experience unending suffering) his life shall preserve it.

**Luke 19:10** For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost (experience unending suffering).

**Luke 19:47** And he taught daily in the temple. But the chief priests and the scribes and the chief of the people sought to destroy (experience unending suffering) him,

**Luke 20 :16** He shall come and destroy (experience unending suffering) these husbandmen, and shall give the vineyard to others. And when they heard [it], they said, God forbid.

Luke 21:18 But there shall not an hair of your head perish (experience unending suffering).

**John 3:15** That whosoever believeth in him should not perish (experience unending suffering), but have eternal life.

**John 3:16** For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish (experience unending suffering), but have everlasting life.

**John 6:12** When they were filled, he said unto his disciples, Gather up the fragments that remain, that nothing be lost (experience unending suffering).

**John 6:27** Labour not for the meat which perisheth (experience unending suffering), but for that meat which endureth unto everlasting life, which the Son of man shall give unto you: for him hath God the Father sealed.

**John 6:39** And this is the Father's will which hath sent me, that of all which he hath given me I should lose (experience unending suffering) nothing, but should raise it up again at the last day.

**John 10 :10** The thief cometh not, but for to steal, and to kill, and to destroy (experience unending suffering): I am come that they might have life, and that they might have [it] more abundantly.

**John 10 :28** And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall (experience unending suffering) never perish (experience unending suffering), neither shall any [man] pluck them out of my hand.

**John 11:50** Nor consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and that the whole nation perish (experience unending suffering) not.

John 12:25 He that loveth his life shall lose (experience unending suffering) it; and he that hateth his

- life in this world shall keep it unto life eternal.
- **John 17:12** While I was with them in the world, I kept them in thy name: those that thou gavest me I have kept, and none of them is lost (experience unending suffering), but the son of perdition; that the scripture might be fulfilled.
- **John 18:9** That the saying might be fulfilled, which he spake, Of them which thou gavest me have I lost (experience unending suffering) none.
- **John 18:14** Now Caiaphas was he, which gave counsel to the Jews, that it was expedient that one man should die (experience unending suffering) for the people.
- **Acts 5 :37** After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished (experience unending suffering); and all, [even] as many as obeyed him, were dispersed.
- **Rom 2:12** For as many as have sinned without law shall also perish (experience unending suffering) without law: and as many as have sinned in the law shall be judged by the law;
- **Rom 14 :15** But if thy brother be grieved with [*thy*] meat, now walkest thou not charitably. Destroy (experience unending suffering) not him with thy meat, for whom Christ died.
- **1Cor 1:18** For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish (experience unending suffering) foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.
- **1Cor 1:19** For it is written, I will destroy (experience unending suffering) the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent.
- **1Cor 8:11** And through thy knowledge shall the weak brother perish (experience unending suffering), for whom Christ died?
- **1Cor 10 :9** Neither let us tempt Christ, as some of them also tempted, and were destroyed (experience unending suffering) of serpents.
- **1Cor 10 :10** Neither murmur ye, as some of them also murmured, and were destroyed (experience unending suffering) of the destroyer.
- **1Cor 15:18** Then they also which are fallen asleep in Christ are perished (experience unending suffering).
- **2Cor 2:15** For we are unto God a sweet savour of Christ, in them that are saved, and in them that perish (experience unending suffering):
- **2Cor 4:3** But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost (experience unending suffering):
- 2Cor 4:9 Persecuted, but not forsaken; cast down, but not destroyed (experience unending suffering);
- **2Thess 2:10** And with all deceivableness of unrighteousness in them that perish (experience unending suffering); because they received not the love of the truth, that they might be saved.
- **Heb 1:11** They shall perish (experience unending suffering); but thou remainest; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment;
- **Jas 1:11** For the sun is no sooner risen with a burning heat, but it withereth the grass, and the flower thereof falleth, and the grace of the fashion of it perisheth (experience unending suffering): so also shall the rich man fade away in his ways.
- **Jas 4:12** There is one lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy (experience unending suffering): who art thou that judgest another?
- **1Pet 1:7** That the trial of your faith, being much more precious than of gold that perisheth (experience unending suffering), though it be tried with fire, might be found unto praise and honour and glory at the appearing of Jesus Christ:
- **2Pet 3:6** Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished (experience

## unending suffering):

- **2Pet 3:9** The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish (experience unending suffering), but that all should come to repentance.
- **2John 1:8** Look to yourselves, that we lose (experience unending suffering) not those things which we have wrought, but that we receive a full reward.
- **Jude 1:5** I will therefore put you in remembrance, though ye once knew this, how that the Lord, having saved the people out of the land of Egypt, afterward destroyed (experience unending suffering) them that believed not.
- **Jude 1:11** Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of Balaam for reward, and perished (experience unending suffering) in the gainsaying of Core.
